1. A word essay with a minimum of 250 words (typed only – handwritten will not be accepted) on the following topic:

"The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?"

Two (2) letters of recommendation (i.e., instructors, counselors, clergy, etc.). These letters must accompany this application but may be enclosed in a sealed envelope.

- 2. A copy of your most current official high school or college transcript. If the school will be sending this transcript under separate cove, attach a brief note so stating.
- 3. A copy of a letter, with date of acceptance from the institution you plan to attend.
- 4. A recent 2" x 3" photograph of yourself (for publicity use only).
- 5. A completed and notarized application release form (included in this application).

Application that doesn't include ALL this supporting documentation will be returned.
